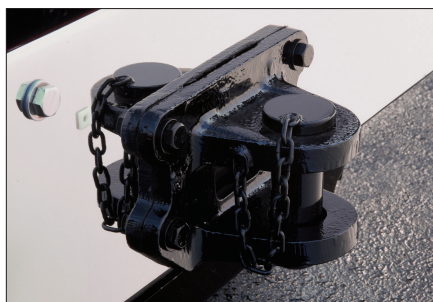

Bumpers on the Model 367 accommodate both a center tow hook configuration and a dual removable pin configuration that meet TMC towing guidelines of 80,000 pounds.
